Macau Tower CNY Charity Walk 2026: Soaring to New Horizons in the Year of the Horse

[19 February 2026 – Macao] Macau Tower Convention & Entertainment Centre ("Macau Tower") upholds its tradition of the tower climb on the third day of the Chinese New Year, grandly hosted the CNY Charity Tower Walk today. This year, more than 2,000 participants joined the event to symbolize steady progress and smooth sailing in all endeavors, while uniting in compassion through the spirit of the climb to embark on a new chapter together.

The Tower Walk was divided into two sessions: the full-course challenge "Strike it Rich" in the morning, and a half-course challenge "Shortcut to Riches" in the afternoon. The morning's full-course tower climb was divided into men's, women's, and youth divisions, with around 600 participants who trekked up 1,298 steps from ground level to 61/F and competed for the glory of the fastest "tower climbers". This year, the champion of the Men's race, a first-time participant, Ho Chun Ting Timothy, crossed the finish line in 7 minutes 59 seconds. He said after the race, "I'm delighted to gather with everyone during the Lunar New Year. I made a special trip from Hong Kong this morning for my first-ever attempt at the event, and I'm pleased to have achieved a faster time than I expected. I wish everyone good fortune in the Year of the Horse." While the champion of the Women's race, Ruby Mak, crossed the finish line in 11 minutes and 8 seconds. She expressed after the race, "This is my fourth time participating, and I'm thrilled to have achieved my personal best. It's especially meaningful to join the event together with my mother and daughter this year." In the afternoon, the half-course challenge "Shortcut to Riches" started from 38/F, finishing at the observation deck, where they could enjoy sweeping views of Macao's stunning skyline and embrace the festive joy of the New Year.

The CNY Charity Walk is Macau Tower's signature New Year event since its introduction in 2009, and it has attracted more than 20,000 citizens and tourists to join over the years. With the strong support of Skypark Macau Tower, Macau Coca-Cola, Macau Flying Eagle Association and Macau Red Cross, the event demonstrates a shared wish for Macao's prosperity and harmony. At the same time, it raises funds for the Macau Red Cross, spreading warmth and care to those in need and making every step of the climb a meaningful one filled with love and hope.
